International franchisors looking to expand business operations into Québec need to be mindful of the key differences in the franchise model unique to the province — compared to the rest of Canada — in order to effectively tap into this potentially lucrative market and avoid legal issues. In addition to navigating through the province's unique language rules, franchisors also need to be cognizant of what differentiates Québec's legal system from that of the rest of North America: it is governed by a single and comprehensive piece of legislation and not by precedential decision-making as in a common law system.
